WATER TESTING

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture has again agreed to send Kimberly Kaiser to our annual meeting to test water samples for our members. You will need to collect a fresh one half cup water sample from your tap. If you have a nitrate removal system bring a sample from before and after the treatment system. You can bring the sample in any clean container that has been washed and rinsed out thoroughly. Be at city hall anytime between 6:00 and 7:00 for this testing.
