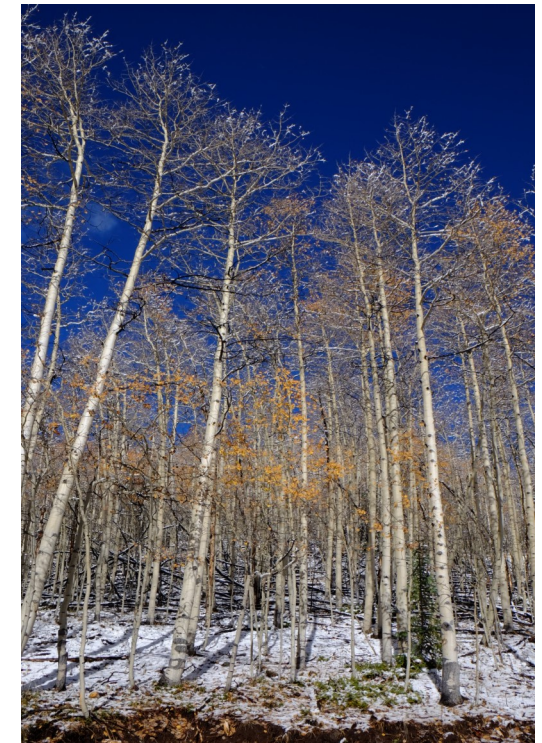

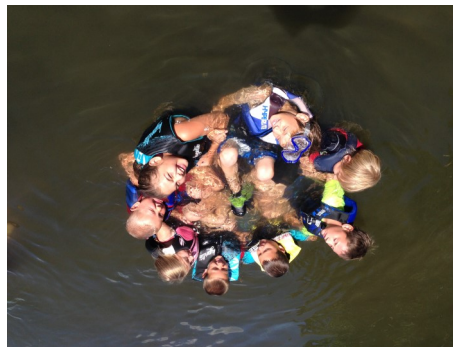
The Easter Egg Hunt upheld the same rock star status of years past with a large family turnout and an appearance by The Easter Bunny.
