The Carpenters, Faye and Jim, moved into the neighborhood in 1979 on Olson Lake. Then President of Tri-Lakes Improvement Association, Ken Sovereign, recruited Jim immediately to serve on the board. From that point, Jim served over 28 years in various board positions, which is believed to be the longest serving member to date. Faye has served on multiple Tri-Lakes committees including the Welcome Committee and currently the Socials Committee. They have hosted the socials several times at their

home.

More importantly, Jim and Faye have a long history and experience in water skiing. Their involvement and experience with the Ski Otters in White Bear Lake led them to start water ski lessons & ski show 28 years ago on Olson Lake using their own skis, ropes and boats. Since then, the show has matured and moved to several different beaches on Lake Jane, but Jim and Faye continue to lead the program.

For years Jim drove the ski boats and according to Faye, "No boat driver since Jim could take five skiers at a time, and then 'hot dock' and pick up five more for a total of ten skiers at a time". Faye noted that the ski show started with 15 members and now has at least 55 skiers each summer.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH PROGRAM

Neighborhood Watch is a safety program where neighbors and both the Washington County Sheriff, and the Oakdale Police Departments work together to increase public and community safety. The Tri-Lakes area is divided into 9 zones of which 5 zones already have Zone Chairs. These Chairs are working to contact neighbors to obtain email and phone information to increase neighborhood connections in case of emergency situations.

Currently, we are looking for Zone Chairs and Block Captains for Zones 1, 2, 6 and 7. You can see the location of these Zones on the URL attached below. Zone Chairs recruit Block Captains for their zone and provide them with materials to share with neighbors.
